Most of these cases arose out of legal proceedings before the courts or the Intellectual Property Office of Singapore and were successfully mediated to satisfactory resolution, with the disputants having discovered and believing in the "magic of mediation" for dispute resolution. Of particular mention are at least a couple of cases where pending legal proceedings spanning multiple jurisdictions (3 countries in one case and 6 countries in the other case) were ongoing and involved in the dispute, all of which the mediated settlement in Singapore effectively disposed of without the need for further litigation under the disparate laws applicable to the various legal proceedings (see Testimonials below)
