I have mediated well over 1000 disputes ranging from breach of contract between distributors and manufacturers, allocation of funds from recovered art confiscated in the Holocaust, large venture capital and hedge fund investments and crypto-currency disputes.

I have combined my extensive business and legal background to provide unique and practicable skills to facilitate settlements between parties. As a former currency and financial instruments trader at The CME Group's International Monetary Market in Chicago, I mediated very large monetary disputes among traders and institutional market participants. As an executive vice president of a foreign exchange arbitrage firm, I developed the business sense and pragmatism necessary to fashion satisfactory settlement options for disputing parties. As the host of a daily live financial television program in Chicago, I gained the reputation of a fair and impartial moderator who carefully evaluated the issues and built a consensus among disparate participants. As a judicial extern at the First District, California State Court of Appeal, I developed the skills to evaluate the legal implications of the dispute. As an educator at University of California, Hastings College of the Law, I wrote articles and made many presentations about the effective use of mediation, arbitration and other ADR procedures. And as a full time neutral attorney arbitrator and mediator for the past 25 years, I have served as a dispute resolver in almost every area of the commerce including new areas of international trade including crypto-currency and bitcoin mining.
